

Bridle Path, Old Buck, Seymour Grind, Bottle Top, BP 25 km

Getting There

Follow Mount Seymour Pkwy to Berkley. Turn onto Berkley and head to the end of the street till it becomes Hyannis Drive. Turn left on Hyannis. Park on street.

Trailhead

- Find marker indicating the trail at the small parking lot at the west end of Hyannis Drive.

Hyannis Trail

- Start on Hyannis Connector heading north.
- About 600 m along, watch for Bridle Path marker and turnoff to the **right**.

Bridle Path

- Continue on Bridle Path for about 1 km, cross a bridge and you come to the intersection of Baden-Powell and Bridle Path. (photo)

- Cross bridge, turn left over the rock.

Bridle Path

- At T-junction, turn right and take Bridle Path Trail toward Mt Seymour Road.
- Watch for left turn at a marked junction.
- After a climb, you come to a **large burned out stump** on your right and a stream straight ahead (there's a post near Cardiac Bypass on your left). Keep right and cross the stream.
- Just over the stream, you reach bottom of **Good Samaritan**. Keep right on Bridle.
- About 1.3 km along, the trail takes a sharp left and heads northeast.
- About 800 m later, you come to a T-junction and gate where the Old Buck Trail intersects.

Old Buck Trail

- Turn left and head north up Old Buck Trail for about 1.2 km.

Baden-Powell

- At the Baden-Powell junction, turn left on the wide trail.
- Follow B-P to post (on your left). Turn **LEFT** (down) to continue on B-P following signage to top of Seymour Grind (fairly straight).
- Head down B-P (left).
- You return to intersection of Bridle Path at post.

Bridle Path

- Turn **RIGHT**. You arrive at intersection of Bridle Path at the stream (photo).
- Cross rock, turn **RIGHT** along Bridle Path and return to T-junction at Hyannis Connector (post).
- Turn **RIGHT** toward Powerline.
- Immediate **LEFT** over Mystery Creek Bridge.

Powerline and Ned's

- Take trail on your right to get to Ned's.
- At T-junction, turn **LEFT** and descend.
- At T-junction, turn right on Bottle Top.

Bottle Top

- **WATCH FOR FIRST LEFT**. Take first left to continue on Bottle Top.
- **At fork with really big log and post, keep right.**
- Follow Bottle Top spectacular trail till you come out at Fisherman's Trail at Seymour River. (You will be able to hear the river as it gets closer.)

Fisherman's past Homestead

- Turn right on Fisherman's, cross Twin Bridges.
- Turn right after the bridge and stay on Fisherman's till you reach the **gate** at Homestead.

Circuit 8

- Continue on Fisherman's past Homestead.
- About 1 km along, **WATCH** for left turn up Circuit 8. Climb Circuit 8.
- At first Y fork, turn **RIGHT**, follow ridge.
- At first **LEFT**, turn left and you arrive back at top of Circuit 8. Keep right.
- Cross old road. At new road, turn left and follow road 1 km back to gazebo.

Suspension Bridge/Baden-Powell Trail

- Find Suspension Bridge trail and post.
- Pass the Suspension Bridge 30 Foot Pool turnoff.
- At the marker for Suspension Bridge (also shows park hours), go right and head southwest.
- At the next turnoff, go straight (do not take the turnoff to the Suspension Bridge) but go towards Twin Falls.
- Go over boardwalks through the marsh.
- At the fork at the top of the climb, turn left to stay on B-P. **Marker indicates 0.5 km to Lillooet Road.**
- Cross Lillooet Road and find the Baden-Powell sign.
- Stay straight on Baden-Powell (cross Powerline Service Road) and cross Pipeline Bridge.

Fisherman's to Powerline

- Continue on B-P till you come to a 3-way junction at Riverside Drive.
- Stay left on B-P.
- At the marked junction, turn left toward Twin Bridges, to get onto Fisherman's Trail.
- Follow Fisherman's to Mystery Creek turnoff.
- Turn right up Mystery Creek switchback.
- After approx. 800 m, Mystery Creek Trail spills out onto the BC Hydro Powerline.
- Turn **RIGHT** along Powerline until it crosses Mystery Creek **BRIDGE**.
- Take an **IMMEDIATE RIGHT** onto Hyannis Connector.

Hyannis Connector

- Follow the connector (main trail) back to Hyannis Drive.
